Google Earth and associated software have the potential to revolutionise the exploration of our planet by teachers and pupils alike and provide a range of practical tools to teach geography in new and creative ways. This freely available mapping resource can enhance pupils' understanding of a vast range of planetary data, including the natural world, geopolitical boundaries, climate and environmental conditions.

This half day session includes an overview and demonstrations of the software, tabulated against a summary of the curriculum areas being met. Delegates will each have access to a computer (Windows or AppleMac) for guided personal exploration of the software features and how these may also support the teaching of History and other Humanities subjects.
